This faculty member will be a key contributor in our efforts to implement project based learning across our teacher preparation programs. The position is a full-time, 9 month appointment with the option of summer teaching for additional pay. Years-in-rank are negotiable. Responsibilities include:

- Teach courses in both graduate and undergraduate level teacher licensure programs
- Collaborate with colleagues in curriculum and program development
- Establish and maintain partnerships with public schools and informal education organizations, to include serving as the departmental liaison to the regional STEM Hub
- Supervise student teachers in field settings
- Advise and recruit students
